("Jay") Fonkert is a Minnesota-based genealogical researcher, writer, and educator with special interests in 19th-century Kentucky and Midwest families, English genealogy, and Dutch-American immigration. A Director of the Association of Professional Genealogists (2010-2015), he is a past-president of the Minnesota Genealogical Society and is Co-Managing Editor of *Minnesota Genealogy*, the Society's

quarterly journal. He has been an instructor at the Salt Lake Institute of Genealogy and has published more than 60 research, teaching and review articles in the *National Genealogical Society Quarterly*, *NGS Magazine*, *APG Quarterly*, *Crossroads*, *Family Chronicle*, *The Septs*, and *Minnesota Genealogist*.
